Responsibilities:

Participate in on-field activities, including first pitches, starting lineups, the National Anthem, and between-inning contests. They also greet fans and special guests, pose for pictures, sign autographs, participates in birthday parties, and goes to community events when requested. In addition, the mascot performer will be responsible for communicating any problems with the costume or repairs needed to the Assistant General Manager or the Community Relations Manager

- The ability to stand with a heavy costume on for long stretches of time
- Physical communication skills (physical gestures, not speaking)
- Have reliable transportation
