The Worcester Bravehearts Baseball Team has developed an intensive internship program that prepares its participants for a career in sports. Students who intern with the Worcester Bravehearts immediately become part of the gameday staff, learning the different aspects of their own department, as well as the every day functions of the team. We help our interns succeed by preparing for and learning from actual situations at the ballpark which are discussed daily. The Bravehearts offer two internship paths in Ballpark Operations:



### **Grounds Crew Internship**

The Worcester Bravehearts Grounds Crew is the team that gets the team on the field. Learn from the Bravehearts general manager, and be directly involved on the field. This internship is best for those with landscaping experience, or those who are looking for extended summer internship hours. Some aspects of this internship include:

- Assisting in pre-game field care including painting lines, raking dirt and filling bases
- Lead Tarp Crew during tarp pulls
- Manage daily upkeep of stadium including fixing broken seat parts, doors, etc.
- Work to assist in putting up and displaying all sponsor signage on-field
- Be the point of contact for all non-baseball events at stadium

Interns will also work on non-gamedays if a non-baseball event is happening at the stadium or if field upkeep is required. Compensation is hourly and based on a weekly schedule.

### **Ballpark Operations Internship**

The Worcester Bravehearts Ballpark Operations internship works hand-in-hand with the team's grounds crew. This internship deals with the everyday execution of an event at Fitton Field. Some aspects of this internship include

- Controlling traffic in the team's parking garage
- Working with security at front gate
- Controlling flow of foot traffic in ballpark
- Keeping cleanliness of ballpark by monitoring trash overflow in barrels and in stands
- Managing team "Heart Carts" used for transporting fans to front gate
- Captain post-game clean up of ballpark

Interns will also work on non-gamedays if a non-baseball event is happening at the stadium or if field upkeep is required. Compensation is hourly and based on a weekly schedule.
